OUTLINE FOR PASSOVER

(The **first section** I plain to read the six lines.)

(Then three people are to read three plagues each. This will involve the nine plagues only.) [About 10 minutes]

(Later the 10th plague)

(**Second section** there will be brief lines of the first Passover. There will a person who will read the part.)

(**Third section** there will be of **THE WALK**. There will be six people and each one will read their part. This will mostly be within the New Testament.) [About 10 to 20 minutes]

(**Forth section** there will be the partaking of the Passover, the bread, the bitter herbs and then the last will be of the wine.) [About 1 hour ±]

(I will ask Elohim to bless the Passover, the bread and bitter herbs.)

(After we have partaken of the Passover, the bread and the bitter herbs, then last thing we will partake of is the wine. There will be a blessing of the wine.)

(**Sixth section** there will be some of the last words of the Messiah.) [About 3 to 5 minutes]

First section

Yahua said unto Moses, 'I have made thee an Elohim.' 'I have made Aaron thy brother your Prophet.'

1. Thou shalt speak all that I command thee: Aaron thy brother shall speak unto Pharaoh that he sends the children of Israel out of his land.

- 2. Pharaoh shall not hearken unto you that I may lay My hand upon Egypt.
- 3. Then thou shalt say unto Aaron, Take thy rod, and cast it before Pharaoh, and it shall become a serpent.
- 4. Now the magicians of Egypt, they also did in like manner with their enchantments.
- 5. For they cast down every man his rod, and they became serpents: but Aaron's rod swallowed up their rods.

(Then the 9 plagues will be read.)

Second section

And Yahua said to Moses, "I will bring one more plague on Pharaoh and on Egypt. Afterward he will let you go from here. When he lets you go, he will surely drive you out of here altogether.

Now Yahua spoke to Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying, "This month shall be your beginning of months; it shall be the first month of the year to you.

Speak to all the congregation of Israel, saying: 'On the tenth of this month every man shall take for himself a lamb, according to the house of his father, a lamb for a household.

And if the household is too small for the lamb, let him and his neighbor next to his house take it according to the number of the persons; according to each man's need you shall make your count for the lamb.

Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year. You may take it from the sheep or from the goats. Now you shall keep it until the fourteenth day of the same month. Then the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it between the evenings.

And they shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and on the lintel of the houses where they eat it. Then they shall eat the flesh on that night; roasted in fire, with unleavened bread and with bitter herbs they shall eat it.

'For I will pass through the land of Egypt on that night, and will strike all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the Elohim of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am Yahua.

Now the blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you are. And when I see the blood, I will pass over you; and the plague shall not be on you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt.

TENTH PLAGUE THE COMPLETION

And Yahua said unto Moses, "Yet will I bring one plague upon Pharaoh, and upon Egypt; afterwards he will let you go hence: when he shall let go, he shall surely thrust you out hence altogether.

The man Moses was very great in the land of Egypt, in the sight of Pharaoh's servants, and in the sight of the people.

And Moses said, Thus says Yahua, **About midnight will I go out into the midst of Egypt:**

And all the firstborn in the land of Egypt shall die, from the firstborn of Pharaoh that sits upon his throne.

Even unto the firstborn of the maidservant that is behind the mill; and all the firstborn of beasts.

And there shall be a great cry throughout all the land of Egypt, such as there was none like it.

Third section THE WALK:

1. SIN AND DEATH TAINT US

If your right eye causes you to sin, pluck it out and cast *it* from you; for it is more profitable for you that one of your members perish, than for your whole body to be cast into hell.

"Whoever causes one of these little ones who believe in Me to sin, it would be better for him if a millstone were hung around his neck, and he were drowned in the depth of the sea.

Most assuredly, I say to you, whoever commits sin is a slave of sin.

Therefore by the deeds of the Torah no flesh will be justified in His sight, for by the Torah is the knowledge of sin.

Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in its lusts.

The sting of death is sin, and the strength of sin is the law.

Whoever commits sin also commits lawlessness, and sin is lawlessness.

2. RESCUE FROM SIN: WHO TAKES AWAY THE SINS OF THE WORLD

I will rescue you from their bondage, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments.

"Behold the Lamb, Who takes away the sins of the world."

Yahua delivered us from so great a death.

This is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me.

In whom we trust that He will still deliver us, who gave Himself for our sins, that He might deliver us from this present evil age, according to the will of our Elohim and Father.

And Yahua will deliver us from every evil work and preserve us for His Heavenly Kingdom.

Yahua knows how to deliver the godly out of temptations.

He will send them a Savior and a Mighty One, and He will deliver them.

Defending, He will also deliver you. Passing over, He will preserve you.

This cup is the New Covenant in My blood. This does, as often as you drink in remembrance of Me."

3. GO THROUGH THE DOOR: ENTER HIS HOUSE: WALK RIGHTEOUSLY

Who may ascend into the hill of Yahua? Or who may stand in His holy place?

He who has clean hands and a pure heart.

Who has not lifted up his soul to an idol, nor sworn deceitfully.

He shall receive blessing from Yahua, and righteousness from the Elohim of his salvation.

Blessed are they whose iniquities are forgiven, and whose sins are covered.

Blessed is the man to whom Yahua will not impute sin.

We are His workmanship, created in Messiah Yashua for good works.

Walk in wisdom toward those who are outside, redeeming the time.

Walk worthy of Elohim who calls you into His own Kingdom and Glory.

We walk in the light as He is in the light, and the blood of Yashua Messiah His Son cleanses us from all sin.

Then the righteous will shine forth as the sun in the Kingdom of their Father.

The righteous before Elohim walk in all the commandments and ordinances of Yahua.

The righteous requirement of the Torah might be fulfilled in us who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.

Manifest evidence of the righteous judgment of Elohim that you may be counted worthy of the Kingdom of Elohim.

The eyes of Yahua are on the righteous and His ears are open to their prayers.

4. WE BECOME CLEAN: RICHES OF ELOHIM

Messiah also loved the church and gave Himself for her, that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the Word.

Yashua, living stone, rejected indeed by men, but chosen by Elohim and precious; you also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to Elohim through Yashua Messiah.

Who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed.

The riches of His goodness, forbearance, and longsuffering He made known His glory on the vessels of mercy.

Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of Elohim!

In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace the eyes of your understanding being enlightened.

Messiah dwells in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love.

5. PREPARE FOR A JOURNEY

Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Messiah was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

No condemnation to those who are in Messiah Yashua, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.

The righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.

For we walk by faith, not by sight. Ye are the temple of the living Elohim.

"I WILL DWELL IN THEM AND WALK AMONG THEM. I WILL BE THEIR ELOHIM, AND THEY SHALL BE MY PEOPLE."

For we are His workmanship, created in Messiah Yashua for good works, which Elohim prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

Walk as children of light as you have received Messiah Yashua Yahua, so walk in Him.

Walk in wisdom toward those outside, redeeming the time.

We walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Yashua Messiah His Son cleanses us from all sin

Blessed is he who watches, and keeps his garments.

6. FOLLOW HIS LIGHT

"Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men."

And he who does not take his cross and follow after Me is not worthy of Me. "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me.

For to this you were called, because Messiah also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you should follow His steps:

These were redeemed from among men, first fruits to Elohim and to the Lamb.

For indeed Messiah, our Passover was sacrificed for us.

Passing over, He will preserve you.

As they were eating, Yashua took bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to the disciples and said, "Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me."

He also took the cup **after supper**, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood; this do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me."

Now before the Feast of the Passover, when Yashua knew that His hour had come that He should depart from this world to the Father, having loved His own who were in the world, He loved them to the end.

After that, He poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe with the towel with which He was girded.

"What I am doing you do not understand now, but you will know after this."

"Do you know what I have done to you?

Most assuredly, I say to you, a servant is not greater than his master; nor is he who is sent greater than He who sent him.

For some thought, because Judas had the money box, that Yashua had said to him, "Buy those things we need for the feast," or that he should give something to the poor. Having received the piece of bread, he then went out immediately. And it was night.

"Now the Son of Man is glorified, and Elohim is glorified in Him.

By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."

And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.

And where I go you know, and the way you know.

"I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works.

"I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser.

Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away; and every branch that bears fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit.

You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you.

Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me.

"I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.

If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you.

By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples.

If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love, just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love.

You are My friends if you do whatever I command you.
